Admission Requirements

Preschool (Nursery to Prefirst)

1. Original and two photocopies of the student's updated birth certificate.
2. Photocopy of the student's updated CURP (Unique Population Registry Code).
3. Photocopy of the vaccination record.
4. Photocopy of official ID and CURP for both parents. For foreign parents, a copy of the passport and corresponding CURP.
5. Clearance letter (no outstanding balance) from the previous school.
6. Copies of report cards from the previous school year (SEP and internal).
7. During the first week of classes, submit to Student Services the original and two photocopies of the Preschool Certificate (only for students entering PreFirst).
8. SEP withdrawal form from the previous school, signed and stamped, if the transfer takes place during the current school year (applicable starting in K3).
9. Updated Tax Status Certificate (only if an invoice is required).

Elementary (1st–5th Grade) & Middle School (6th Grade)

1. Original and two photocopies of the birth certificate (please verify it is up to date).
2. Photocopy of the student's updated CURP (Unique Population Registry Code).
3. Photocopy of the CURP.
4. Photocopy of official ID and CURP for both parents. For foreign parents, a copy of the passport and corresponding CURP.
5. Clearance letter (no outstanding balance) from the previous school.
6. Copies of report cards from the previous school year (SEP and internal).
7. During the first week of classes, submit to Student Services the original and two photocopies of the Preschool Certificate (only for students entering 1st grade).
8. SEP withdrawal form from the previous school, signed and stamped, if the transfer takes place during the current school year.
9. Updated Tax Status Certificate (only if an invoice is required).

Middle School (7th–8th Grade) y *High School (9th–12th Grade)

1. Original and two photocopies of the birth certificate (please verify it is up to date).
2. Photocopy of the student's updated CURP (Unique Population Registry Code).
3. Photocopy of official ID and CURP for both parents. For foreign parents, a copy of the passport and corresponding CURP.
4. Clearance letter (no outstanding balance) from the previous school.
5. Copies of report cards from the previous school year (SEP and internal).
6. SEP withdrawal form from the previous school, signed and stamped, if the transfer takes place during the current school year.
7. During the first week of classes, submit to Student Services the original and two photocopies of: Elementary School Certificate (students entering 7th grade), Middle School Certificate (students entering 10th grade), or Partial Transcript (students entering 11th or 12th grade).
8. Updated Tax Status Certificate (only if an invoice is required).
